# Michael Flock-Reisinger (影片請點此)

Michael Flock-Reisinger studied with Claus Kanngiesser and the Quartets Amadeus and Alban Berg Cologne at the University of Music and Dance (HfMT Köln).

In 1992 he received a scholarship to study with the members of the Amadeus Quartet in London. From 1994 to 1996 he was a scholarship holder of the Berlin Philharmonic's Orchestra Academy as a student of Jörg Baumann and Georg Faust – a formative artistic experience among the great conductors of our time: Claudio Abbado, Bernard Haitink and others.

M. Flock-Reisinger has completed numerous master classes with cellists such as Wolfgang Boettcher, Wen-Sin Yang, Jens-Peter Maintz, Ralph Kirshbaum and Steven Isserlis, who twice invited him to the renowned chamber music festival Cornwall. In 1998 he became a permanent member of the Düsseldorf Symphony Orchestra. Within the framework of this position, he has since been involved in chamber music in a variety of ways. Since 2009 he has been a member of the Bayreuth Festival Orchestra.

### Sandra Brune Mathar (<u>影片請點此</u>)

Sandra Brune Mathar née Blazevic was born in Belgrade in a family of musicians. At the age of five she had her first piano lessons with Prof. Gordana Malinovic. At the age of sixteen she began her studies with Prof Olga Jovanovic at the Music Academy in Belgrade and graduated in 1988 with distinction as "Student of the Year".

After winning numerous prizes in regional and national competitions, she moved to the Academy of Music in Munich in 1988 to study with Prof. Gitti Pirner. She finished her studies with distinction and was accepted into the master class.

Already during her studies she developed a passion for pedagogical work. She taught as a piano teacher for eight years at the Music School München-Vaterstätten.

Several prize winners of children and youth competitions emerged from her class.Participation in master classes of Bruno Leonardo Gelber and Oleg Meisenberg gave her further musical impulses.

In 1994 Sandra Brune Mathar became a lecturer at the University of Music in Munich. This was followed by a position for ballet accompaniment at the Bavarian Theater Academy with a focus on piano improvisation. In 1998 she moved to Düsseldorf and became a lecturer at the Robert Schumann Hochschule. Since 2021 Sandra Brune Mathar has



held a permanent piano teacher position at the Robert Schumann Hochschule in Düsseldorf.

The participation in master classes of Bruno Leonardo Gelber and Oleg Meisenberg are of great importance for her pianistic development.

Chamber music and song accompaniment are an essential part of her pianistic work.

Her chamber music partners in violin and piano include Robert Bokor, Ilona Cudek, Ryoko Yano and Joji Hattori.

Her musical partners include renowned singers such as Morenike Fadayomi, Sebastian Rheintaller, Alexandra von der Weth, Bruno Ballmeli, Diana Orlanova and Bosiljka Jovanovic.

Sandra Brune Mathar has performed as a soloist with Belgrade Philharmonic Orchestra, Munich Symphony Orchestra and Cameratta Louis Spor.

She is also very interested in ballet music, resulting in a production with choreographer Anna Vita at Mainfranken Theater Würzburg.

Literature is also a constant source of inspiration for her and finds expression in the CD production with the actor Rainer Görnemann "Liebesbriefe Deutscher Komponisten" Rondo Verlag.

Her pianistic activity is documented on four CDs with mainly romantic repertoire.



# Annette Reisinger (影片請點此)

Annette Reisinger studied at the Berlin University of the Arts (UDK) with Kolja Blacher and Mi-Kyung Lee. Master classes with Ana Chumachenko,

Thomas Brandis and Werner Scholz rounded off her instrumental studies. She is a long-standing member of the Minguet Quartet, which received its chamber music training with Walter Levin, Eberhard Feltz and the members of the Amadeus, Melos and Cherubini Quartets and studied with the Alban Berg Quartet at the Cologne University of Music and Dance (HfMT Köln).

The Minguet Quartet is now one of the string quartets in international demand – in 2020 & 2021 it was a guest at the Salzburg Festival and has been invited again for 2023.

Further projects in the 2022/23 season include concerts at the Prinzregententheater Munich, Gewandhaus zu Leipzig, Arnold Schönberg Center Vienna, at the Meistersingerhalle Nuremberg, the Alte Oper Frankfurt, at L'association Pour l'Art Lausanne, the Meister- und Kammerkonzerte Innsbruck, the Schubertiade Sion and the Schumannfest Düsseldorf. In previous years, the ensemble gave guest performances at BOZAR Music Brussels, the Théâtre des Abbesses Paris, the Mozartfest Würzburg, Grafenegg Festival,



Rheingau Music Festival, the Herrenchiemsee Festival, the International Mozarteum Foundation Salzburg, the Ultraschall Festival Berlin, De Doelen Rotterdam, at the Cologne Philharmonie, Lincoln Center New York, SouthBank Centre London and the Vienna Konzerthaus.

### Vlado Zakto

Received his first lessons in double-bass playing at the Conservatorium of Žilina. From 1997 to 2002 he studied at music academies in Munich, Trossingen and Nürnberg, from 2002 to 2005 in the artistic further education class of the Nürnberg music

academy and finally at a master class there in 2005/06. He has played in numerous youth orchestras, including the Young Munich Philharmonic and the Young Austrian Philharmonic, and has won prizes: in 1997 he was winner of the second prize at the national double-bass competition in Bratislava, in 1997 and 2000 he was successful at the International Czech Double-Bass Competition, and in 2007 he was awarded the scholarship of the Christian Nielsen and Kai Køge Pedersen Foundation. A first firm contract took him in 2006 to the Royal Orchestra and Opera of Copenhagen, where he was promoted to deputy solo double-bass in 1997. Since October 2008 Vlado Zatko has been first solo double-bass of the Düsseldorf Symphonic. Apart from this he has often guested with other orchestras, including the Chamber Orchestra of Munich, the Munich Symphonic, the DR (Danish Radio) Sinfonietta, Sjælands Symfoniorkester, Malmö Symfoniorkester, the Orchestra of the Tyrolean Festival of Erl, the double-bass sextet Bassiona Amorosa and the Solisten-Oktett of Berlin.





### Sophia Bart

Sophia Bart was born in southern Germany in Saulgau, Baden–Württemberg. She took vocal studies at the University of Music in Karlsruhe under Prof. Erika Markgraf and piano studies under Prof. Günter Reinhold. She graduated both subjects with distinction, completed her vocal studies with the diploma for song and oratorio and the degree in opera. In 1982 she

was the first prize-winner at the VDMK competition in the opera category. She attended several master classes with Giuletta Simionato and chamber singer Sena Jurinac.

After her studies she worked at Saarbrücken State Theatre, where she sung a broad repertoire in the mezzo soprano range. Her second appointment was spent at the Bern City Theatre. In 1987 she was engaged by Eberhard Wächter at the Volksoper opera house in Vienna, where she successfully made her début as Rosina from the Barber of Seville. Many other parts followed, from Mozart to Richard Strauss. She made guest appearances on numerous stages in Austria, Switzerland and in Germany.

Since 1990 she has been self-employed. Besides her operatic career she has given several recitals and has made radio recordings with SWR Stuttgart and the Austrian broadcasting company ORF. The mezzo soprano particularly distinguishes herself in Russian and



French songs. A radio recording from the French repertoire with the cycle of Olivier Messiaen Poèmes pour Mi is particularly excellent.

She has taken part in a recording of the opera Stephen Climax by Hans Zender during the Steirischer Herbst festival in Graz. Numerous guest performances followed in Austria, Germany and Poland in concert performance and oratorio, which included singing the alto solo in Gustav Mahler's Symphony No. 2 in the Philharmonic hall in Krakow. Together with famous soloists, she has contributed to a Christmas recording with two arias from the Christmas oratorio of Johann Sebastian Bach for the German television broadcaster ZDF. Moreover, she has attracted great attention in Poland with her performance for a television recording under the direction of Prof. S. Stuligrosz.

Sophia Bart sings under famous conductors such as Jiri Kout, Jun Märkl, Claus Weise, Franz Möst and Erich Binder.

In addition to her active concert work she is assistant professor for vocals and for didactics and methodology in vocal pedagogy at the Robert Schumann School of Music and Media in Düsseldorf and since 2004 has also taught at the Institute For Music and Media.

### 杜塞朵夫 Düsseldorf

杜塞朵夫位於萊茵河畔,以「廣告業、媒體業」聞名,建築非常富有設計感。杜塞朵夫是歐洲培育藝術人才的重要城市之一,除了杜塞朵夫大學,「德國舒曼高等音樂學院」也坐落在此地,為了紀念把一生奉獻給音樂的著名 德國音樂家、教育家 - 羅伯特·舒曼,沿著萊茵河漫步,您可以感受追城市的悠閒與惬意。



### 杜塞朵夫老城

杜塞老城面積僅有半個平方公里,卻 擁有300多個酒吧和舞廳,被稱為「世 界上最長的酒吧」。

杜塞朵夫的「老啤酒」(Altbier)非常有名,用古老的傳統配方釀造,感受城市魅力的同時不仿也來一杯吧。



### 杜塞媒體港、電視塔


座落在萊茵河畔的媒體港,周圍建築融合了人文思 維與雕塑的概念所設計,為歐洲創意產業的中心。 沿著河畔向南就是電視塔,為全市最高的建築,塔 身同時設有世界最大的電子鐘,分小時、分鐘、秒 鐘三段顯示。168樓設有景觀餐廳,可俯瞰全市的 風貌,感受德國的現代化。

### 荷蘭盧爾蒙德暢貨中心 Designer Outlet Roermond

### 科隆 Köln

科隆大教堂、霍亨索倫橋(情人橋) 科隆大教堂佐於科隆的市中心,是一座天主教堂,也是德國第二,世界第三高的教堂,另外選 是世界上第三大的哥德式教堂,聯合國教科文組織於1996年將其列為世界文化遺產,是哥特式建築的典範,除了參觀教堂收藏的珍貴文物之外,建築本身更是一個大型的藝術現實,一同體驗聖堂建築工藝之美。

### 德國決賽常見問題

Q:是自行前往還是由台灣協辦方組團?

A:考量歐洲文化與亞洲差異大,不同於日本、新加坡之便捷,會協助參賽者集體前往,並安排比賽最合適的學習計畫,伙食住宿皆不需擔心,來了一趟歐洲,除了安排參賽者音樂活動,也會走出戶外,不會只待在室內練琴,特別安排兩天半的文化之旅,讓參賽者們不虛此行。

Q:請問行程費用含機票嗎?其他交通費用呢?

A:考慮到機票隨油價浮動,加上現在人都有個家信用卡優惠,僅限協助參賽者安全到達,讓參賽者們在異鄉能保有最好的實力,BCD方案交通部分都包含,但是費用不包含機票和機場到杜賽朵夫的來回接送,這部分請注意。

Q:我有親友住在那,可以只參加比賽和練琴?有些行程不參加嗎?

A:可以的,考慮到台灣團進團出之安全性,僅提供ABCD四種方案,無法個人客製化增減,請包含團體組團的制度性。希望能由我們專業安排,歐洲文化與亞洲差異慎大,台灣區希望盡快協助訂下所有上課及練琴時間,以免琴房被其他區選手租用,台灣讓選手們有足夠穩定性,情緒平穩的準備賽事。

Q:請問選擇A方案,若需要練琴和大師班是額外加選嗎?

A:是的,若選擇A方案,純粹只參加決賽的選手,不包含食宿,其他琴方租用 練琴、提琴租用、當地伴奏、翻譯,可以單獨加選加總,自行前往至8/9 的參賽者,無法在當地臨時加入套組方案,需6/18日截止日前,若需改為 BC方案,請提前告知,好讓台灣協辦提前協助大家在德國安排所有行程。 (協助翻譯、代租用提琴、聯繫當地伴奏皆需額外付費)。



Q:我可以只加購四小時的琴房嗎?或者只報名一堂大師班嗎?

A:不行喔,琴房租用就是八小時喔,大師班加選就是兩堂喔,多練琴,難得聽德國教授的講課,肯定受益無窮。

Q:我小孩滿15歲,可以自行前往嗎?你們會顧著他嗎?

A:建議參加BC方案,可以全程協助滿15歲以上孩子,15歲以下需家長陪同,家長陪同需勾選D方案。

Q:食宿都包含嗎?

A:A方案不含食宿,BCD方案全程三餐皆包含,包含第一天抵達德國的午晚餐,以及離開德國那天的早餐,也都是包含的喔!

Q:請問我選擇A方案,家人陪我去,還要額外選擇D的親友陪同方案嗎?

A:不用喔,D方案就是食宿旅遊車票,方便陪同親友不用再帶著參賽者奔 波,選A方案的陪同親友們,可以自由安排在杜塞朵夫的行程。

Q:請問住宿是哪一間飯店?

A: 會依報名人數來安排三星以上的酒店,行程詳情會於7/17寄送至參賽者信 箱喔。

Q:我們參加全程包套方案,自行搭飛機去要約在哪呢?

A:我們會約8/4在德國法蘭克福機場上午時段集合。台灣航班查詢後,符合此時段有國泰和華航的時間,大概會在8/4,集體於法蘭克福機場8:30集合,因此自行購買機票從台灣出發,大多也會剛好買在此時段,7/17公佈場次時,會個別寄Email告知詳細行程!

Q:是否有建議航班?

A:台灣出發的參賽者,建議搭乘德國時間2023.08.04 早上6:50抵達的中華航空或者國泰航空之班機。



Q:請問8/4在德國法蘭克福機場上午8:30時段集合,接著是集體從法蘭到杜 寒嗎?

A:是的,這段距離是沒有含車資的,有需要的人請加選,屆時會依實際人數報價,於7/1號,個別通知繳費。

Q:大師班有多少堂課?幾點到幾點?

A: 營隊的大師班課程,提供每個人,總共是兩堂個別課+兩堂團體課程,琴房中心開放9~17點這區段時段,7/17會寄送行程表,至報名者的郵件信箱, 安排每一位參賽者大師班及練琴日期及時間,無法指定課程時間和日期喔。

Q:大提琴或低音大提琴可以當地租用嗎?因為攜帶過去得多買一張機票座位?

A:因為多數的人不放心讓樂器托運,擔心摔壞且佔行李重量。帶上客艙就可 能得多買一張機票,所以經濟考量,我們可以協助當地租借大提,但是參 賽者需要自行攜帶弓,並儘早提供提琴型號,我們盡快提前做租借安排。

Q:我需要伴奏怎麼辦?

A:可以提前告知需求,為您登記並協助找當地伴奏,伴奏費用是200歐元 (兩次練習+一次比賽上台),不包含琴房費用。參賽者則可利用原本的琴房 租用時間,和大師班課堂內安排伴奏,則不需另外收取琴房費用。

Q:比賽時全曲彈完嗎?得獎者音樂會第一名才可以參加?

A:不會,除非評審老師特別請您全曲演奏。獲獎者由評審一致性通過榮獲最高榮譽,獲得參加得獎者音樂會,不需額外付費,獲獎者免費提供美輪美 與的古教堂表演廳,不限時間全曲演出,並獲得完整專業錄影。

Q:目前只有弦樂鋼琴有個別大師班?有管樂嗎?
